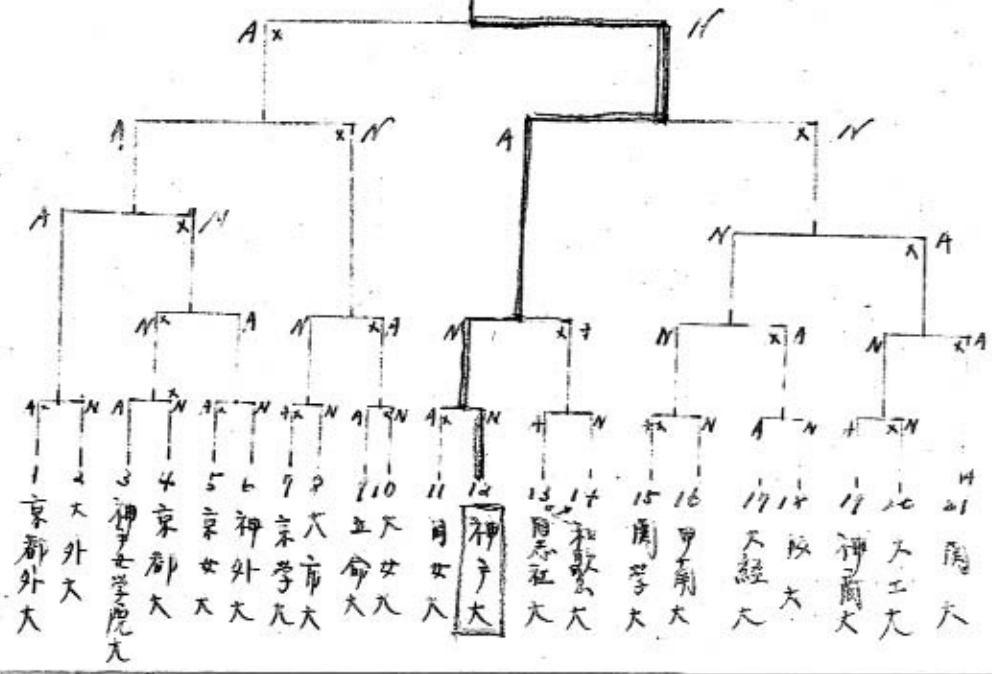

Mr. Chairman, honourable judges, our worthy opponents and ladies and gentlemen. We propose to prove to you why Japan should not make an effort to have the People's Republic of China take its seat in the United Nations. To begin with, we define the words in the resolution as follows.

"Japan" means present Japanese Kishi Government.  
 "Should" is understood as <sup>if necessary</sup> a necessity and desirability with reasonable possibility.

"Make an effort" means that Japanese Government takes some new concrete measures from realistic point of view.

"The People's Republic of China" is defined as the communistic authority which declared its foundation on October 1st, 1949, which we will call "Communist China" or "Red China" in this debate for the convenience sake.

"Take its seat in the United Nation" is defined as follows: Red China becomes a member at the Security Council in the United Nations as the representative government of whole China in replacement of Nationalist China.
